Monitor NMS: No ONMS visitor center but there is The USS Monitor Center within The Mariners' Museum & Park in Newport News, VA. The Monitor Center does charge admission. Site also has exhibits at several smaller museums in North Carolina.

Gray's Reef NMS: No ONMS visitor center but site has exhibits in at least seven other venues in Georgia and South Carolina.

Flower Garden Banks NMS: No ONMS visitor center but the site has exhibits in at least seven other venues in Texas and one in Texnessee, as well as a traveling exhibit with a different host each year.

Channel Islands NMS: No ONMS visitor center but the site has exhibits in at least eight venues throughout south-central California, including an extensive exhibit at the Channel Islands National Park Visitor Center in Ventura (NPS manages the terrestrial islands surrounded by the NMS).
